

**All Livestock and Deliveries MUST come through the new delivery gate on 10th Street.**

1. Competition is open to all residents & non-residents of Cattaraugus County.
2. Open Class Dairy Goats will be judged on Monday at concurrently with 4-H Dairy Goats at 8:30 a.m.
3. Entry blanks in back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office.
4. **Entries close Monday, July 19th at 4:00 P.M.** No late entries will be accepted.
5. The entry fee is 10% of first premium (\$1.00) per class, including group and special classes. There is no entry fee for classes marked "****". The prize for these classes is a Rosette. **All entry fees must be paid in full at time of entry deadline.**
6. Non-members are required to purchase an exhibitor's pass for \$15.00. Individual names must be on these passes. All vehicles must have an exhibitor parking sticker to enter exhibitor gate on 10th Street. Must be affixed to vehicle.
7. Dairy Goats must be in place on Sunday preceding fair by 4:00 P.M. and released Sunday, last day of fair at 6:00 P.M. **All show animals must remain on grounds during entire week.**
8. ADGA rules shall govern.
9. All animals must be tattooed legibly. There will be no pre-show milk-out. Overdistended udders are subject to discrimination. The judge's decision is final. All goats are entered at the sole risk of the owners. Base date for computing the age of goats for classes is the date of the show.
 - a) Registration papers must be presented to the Show Secretary before the show begins.
 - b) Proof of ownership shall be the name on the registration or recordation certificate or stamped duplicate application.
10. All Grand and Reserve Champion animals must compete for Best Doe in Show.
11. All animals shown in group or special classes must have been shown in their regular class.
12. An official health certificate will be required for all entries. All entries must be health-checked prior to the show. Any animals showing signs of contagious disease or condition will be dismissed and prohibited from the show. Rules and standards of the New York State Dept. of Agriculture and Markets for the conduct of Fairs and Livestock Health Requirements shall apply.
13. Specialty classes are judged by breed.
14. Ages for Junior Doe Show (under two & never milked) as follows:
Junior Kid - Born between April 1 of current year & show date
Intermediate Kid - Born between March 1 & March 31 of current year
Senior Kid - Born between January 1 & February 28(29) of current year.
Junior Yearling - Born between May 1 & December 31 of preceding year.

Senior Yearling - Born between August 5, 2 years ago & April 30 preceding year.

Senior Doe Show (Does in milk or have ever milked)

15. Show order will be numerical according to section number.
16. All sheep and goats will comply to the new Scrapie Eradication program. All animals will either have an assigned premises ID number or tattoo on each animal.
17. **"No initial bedding will be provided. Exhibitors should bring their own bedding."**
18. **Any exhibitor who fails to comply with the rules and regulations, reasonable requests, or causes a confrontation with other exhibitors or supervisors will be asked to leave the grounds. All premiums, awards and other payments will be forfeited by the exhibitor.**

All goats must be identified by a legible registration tattoo or a USDA approved official identification tag. See 2005 Health Regulations or your local vet.

ATTENTION: ANIMAL EXHIBITORS

- ★ **No sleeping overnight in the barns by any exhibitor, 19 years of age and under.**
- ★ **All adults intending to stay in the barns must verify with the superintendent of that area.**
- ★ **During the day, exhibitors may rest in the barns, out of the aisles. No beds may be used.**
- ★ **Due to health regulations concerning E-Coli and other contaminations, cooking and eating in the livestock areas is not recommended.**
