General Rules:

1. All entries **must** be in the hands of the Grange Superintendent by June 15th.
2. A regular booth space will be allotted each Grange making an exhibit.
3. There will be no entry fee in this Department.
4. Premiums will be withheld in case an exhibit is not worthy.
5. No advertising of any kind, other than that necessary to the display in the booth, will be permitted.
6. Premiums: each exhibit scoring over 75% shall receive \$70.00. Granges scoring 50-74 points shall receive \$35.00. Prizes of \$20.00, \$15.00, \$10.00 will be awarded respectively for 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes in **each** class.
7. Booths **must be completed** by Monday at 8:00 am. Doors to Corporate Building will be closed and Judging will start at 10:00 am, Monday.
8. No Grange will be allowed to dismantle a booth until 9:00 A.M. Monday.
9. Two Granges may jointly sponsor a single booth, in which case all premium moneys earned by that single booth will be divided equally between the two Granges. All such jointly sponsored booths must comply with all other rules herein stated.

Class 1 - Standard Grange Exhibit

General Display	15 points
Artistic Arrangement	10 points
Vegetables (an adequate display)	10 points
Fruit (an adequate display).....	10 points
Canned Goods (May include jellies, marmalades, conserves, fruit juices, as well as fruits, meats, vegetables.) (Any amount in clear glass containers.)	15 points
Butter and Cheese - 5 lbs. or more	7 points
Maple Sugar and Syrup (an adequate display)	4 points
Fancywork and Sewing (an adequate display).....	10 points
Shelled Grain (an adequate display). No limit on unshelled grains or grasses.....	10 points
Cut Flowers and Potted Plants (no limit)	5 points
Honey - 2 lbs.	2 points
Eggs - 1 dozen	2 points
