

**All Livestock and Deliveries MUST come through the new delivery gate on 10th Street.**

1. Competition is open to all to residents of all counties.
2. Open Class Poultry will be judged - **Sunday, August 1 at 7:00 p.m.**
3. Entry blanks in back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office.
4. **Entries close Monday, July 19th at 4:00 P.M.** Late entries will be accepted only by the Poultry Superintendent, approval based on space available.
5. The entry fee is 10% of first premiums (40 cents). **All entry fees must be paid in full at time of entry deadline.**
6. Non-members are required to purchase an exhibitor's pass for \$15.00. Individual names must be on these passes. All vehicles must have exhibitor sticker to enter exhibitor gate on 10th Street.
7. Poultry must be in place on Sunday preceding fair by 4:00 P.M. and released Sunday, last day of fair at 6:00 P.M.
8. The Society will take every precaution possible for the safekeeping of all exhibits, but assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to person or stock or other exhibits, and upon these conditions only are entries received.
  - a) All chickens exhibited must be certified Typhoid Pollurum Free. Certificates must be provided upon entry.
  - b) All poultry must be identified in the American Standard of Perfection, except for (production type) crossbreeds and show class purebreds not found in the Standard (can only be shown in show class).
  - c) Birds showing signs of lice, mites, or contagious disease will be disqualified and must be removed from the Fairgrounds by the owner within 24 hours or the Fair Association will remove them.

9. An exhibitor may enter and show 2 exhibits of each breed in a class. No exhibitor will be allowed to enter more than four breeds of a species.
10. An exhibit shall be a single bird, except in group classes.
11. Birds hatched prior the January 1 of current year will be considered old. Those hatched after that date will be considered young. No birds hatched after May 1 of current year may be entered.
12. Breed and variety should be identified on the pre-entry form.
13. Exhibitors must care for their birds. Exhibitors must also supply their own feed and water dishes.
14. **"No initial bedding will be provided. Exhibitors should bring their own bedding.**
15. **Any exhibitor who fails to comply with the rules and regulations, reasonable requests, or causes a confrontation with other exhibitors or supervisors will be asked to leave the grounds. All premiums, awards and other payments will be forfeited by the exhibitor.**
