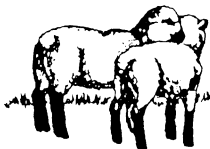




All Livestock and Deliveries MUST come through the new delivery gate on 10th Street. Sheep should check Health Regulations.

1. Competition is open to all residents & non-residents of Cattaraugus County.
2. Open Class Sheep will be judged on Wednesday, following 4-H Sheep at 10:00 A.M.
3. Entry blanks in back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office.
4. **Entries close Monday, July 19th at 4:00 P.M.** Late entries will be accepted only by the Sheep Superintendent, approval based on space available.
5. The entry fee is 10% of first premiums (\$1.00). There is no entry fee for classes marked "***". **All entry fees must be paid in full at time of entry deadline.**
6. Non-members are required to purchase an exhibitor's pass for \$15.00. Individual names must be on these passes. **(All vehicles must have exhibitor sticker to enter exhibitor gate on 10th Street.)**
7. Sheep must be in place on Sunday preceding fair by 4:00 P.M. and released Sunday, last day of fair at 6:00 P.M.
8. The Society will take every precaution possible for the safekeeping of all exhibits, but assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to person or stock or other exhibits, and upon these conditions only are entries received.
 - a) All sheep exhibited must be free from scabe infection. Check NYS Health Regulations.
 - b) Animals from a flock under quarantine for any reason cannot be exhibited.
 - c) No animal will be allowed to unload until examined. **See Health Rules.**
9. All purebred exhibits must be registered in a recognized breeders association and carry association ear tags. Papers must be presented to the superintendent.
10. An exhibitor limited to two entries in each class but may not receive more than two premiums in each individual class and one premium in each group class.
11. A Flock shall consist of one ram, any age; and three ewes, any age.
12. All breeding sheep should be properly fitted and trimmed.
13. All unworthy animals will receive no awards.
14. Rosettes will be awarded for champion Ram and Ewe in each breed.
15. **"No initial bedding will be provided. Exhibitors should bring their own bedding.**



16. Any exhibitor who fails to comply with the rules and regulations, reasonable requests, or causes a confrontation with other exhibitors or supervisors will be asked to leave the grounds. All premiums, awards and other payments will be forfeited by the exhibitor.

ATTENTION: ANIMAL EXHIBITORS

- ★ No sleeping overnight in the barns by any exhibitor, 19 years of age and under.
- ★ All adults intending to stay in the barns must verify with the superintendent of that area.
- ★ During the day, exhibitors may rest in the barns, out of the aisles. No beds may be used.
- ★ Due to health regulations concerning E-Coli and other contaminations, cooking and eating in the livestock areas is not recommended.

SECTION 57 - MARKET LAMBS

1. Individual lambs shown in the purebred Classes cannot be shown in the Market Lamb Class.
2. **Entries close Monday, July 19th at 4:00 P.M.** Late entries will be accepted only by Sheep Superintendant, approval based on space available
3. Entry of lambs into individual weight classification will be based on weight at the Cattaraugus County Fair.
4. All Market Lambs will be weighed at a time to be posted by the Livestock Superintendent. Exhibitors should be available to weigh their lambs.
5. All Market Lambs shall have been shorn (maximum length of 1 inch).
6. No rams shall be shown in Market Lamb classes.
7. This section is open to Purebred, Grade, or Crossbred, wether or ewe lamb born after January 1st of current year.
8. The entry fee is 10% of first premiums (\$1.00). **All entry fees must be paid in full at time of entry deadline.**

Premiums 1st - \$10.00 2nd - \$8.00 3rd - \$6.00

1. Single Market Lamb weighing over 80 lbs.

SECTION 58 - WOOL

1. All wool shall be of the current year.
2. Each fleece shall be tied with paper twine - not over 2 twines each way.
3. There shall be classes for fine, medium, and course wool.
4. The official judge may reclassify fleeces at his discretion.
5. The entry fee is 10% of first premiums (30 cents). **All entry fees must be paid in full at time of entry deadline.**
6. To encourage more careful preparation and handling of fleeces, the following prizes are offered.

Premiums 1st - \$3.00 2nd - \$2.00 3rd - \$1.00
