



1. **Competition is open to resident non-dealers, of all counties. A dealer is anyone who accepts money for their wares and/or services.**
2. Open Class Antiques will be judged Sunday preceding the fair at 9:00 A.M.
3. Exhibitors are required to fill out the entry blank with the proper Department Section and Class Number with the name of the article and description.
4. Entry blanks in back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office.
5. **Entries close Monday, July 18th at 4:00 P.M. This is an absolute deadline!**
6. No Exhibitor may make more than 50 entries.
7. **No entries accepted other than those listed.**
8. Entry fee has been waived by the Fair Association. However, an entry form must be submitted so entry tags/stubs can be issued and prizes awarded.
9. **All articles must be delivered on Saturday, preceding the fair between 10:00 A.M. & 2:00 P.M.**
10. All articles must be called for on **Monday, following the fair** from 10:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M. The Association will not be responsible for articles left after 2:00 P.M. on that day. All exhibits must remain on display the last day of the fair. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entry stubs must be presented for removal of articles.
11. **Entry blanks MUST identify Not Listed Above items.**
12. The same article cannot compete for separate premiums
13. **No premium will be given on any article that has once taken a first premium.**
14. If there is a specific article listed, entries must be entered there and not in the "Not Listed Above" class. Any article entered incorrectly will not be eligible for premium.
15. All entries must be clean and in Good Condition.
16. **All articles must be at least seventy-five (75) years old.**
17. Premiums may be withheld at the discretion of the Judge on unworthy entries or where there is no competition.
18. Entries may be made by mail. If entry is received and postage is enclosed, tags will be mailed. Otherwise, tags will be held at the office until called for.
19. All items must be checked in with Superintendent. Please return all unused entry tags/stubs (items not entered) to the Superintendent the day exhibits are brought in. This will help move the judging along faster.
20. Special award money will be issued on Monday following the fair, with premium checks to follow in the mail.
