*** Professional Corner** - This is for any professional interested in bringing their wares to the fair **For Display Purposes Only**. An entry form clearly marked "**Professional - For Display Purposes Only**" must be submitted with each item to be displayed categorized according to the fair book. There is no fee for displaying your wares. The wares displayed will be determined by the amount of available room. When items are brought in, each should be clearly marked with displayer's name and/or shop. All other fair rules apply.

Best Professional Flower Arrangement Entry
2. Open Class Flowers will be judged Sunday preceding the fair at 4:00 P.M.
3. Exhibitors are required to fill out the entry blank with the proper Department Section and Class Number with the name of the article and description.
4. Entry blanks in back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office.
5. **Entries close Monday, July 18th at 4:00 P.M. This is an absolute deadline!**
6. **No entries accepted other than those listed.**
7. Entry fee has been waived by the Fair Association. However, an entry form must be submitted so entry tags/stubs can be issued and prizes awarded.
8. **All articles must be delivered and arranged on Sunday, preceding the fair Noon-3:30 P.M.**
9. All articles must be called for on **Monday, following the fair** from 10:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M. The Association will not be responsible for articles left after 2:00 P.M. on that day. All exhibits must remain on display the last day of the fair. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entry stubs must be presented for removal of articles.
10. **Entry blanks MUST identify Not Listed Above items.**
11. **All flowers, plants, arrangements, etc. must be entered in real makers name.**
12. Collections cannot compete for separate premiums
13. If there is a specific article listed, entries must be entered there and not in the "Not Listed Above" class. Any article entered incorrectly will not be eligible for premium.
14. Any specimen in a hanging container must be entered under the hanging basket category.
15. In judging; flowers, arrangement and character of vases and containers will be considered.
16. Any cut flowers, potted plants or arrangement having insect pests will not be accepted.
17. **No more than 5 stems per item permitted unless specified.**
18. Premiums may be withheld at the discretion of the Judge on unworthy entries or where there is no competition.

19. Give names of varieties when possible.
20. **EXHIBITORS SHOULD MAINTAIN THEIR EXHIBITS IN GOOD CONDITION.**
21. Entries may be made by mail. If entry is received and postage is enclosed, tags will be mailed. Otherwise, tags will be held at the office until called for.
22. All items must be checked in with Superintendent. Please return all unused entry tags/stubs (items not entered) to the Superintendent the day exhibits are brought in. This will help move the judging along faster.
23. Special award money will be issued on Monday following the fair, with premium checks to follow in the mail.

SECTION 115 - CUT FLOWERS

Any cut flower vases containing a mixture of flowers will automatically be judged in Class 27 - Mixed Bouquet.

A mixed bouquet may include greens and an unlimited number of flowers.
