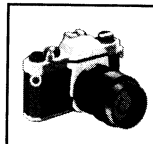

1. Competition is open to non-professional residents of **all counties**. A professional is anyone who accepts money for their wares and/or services.
2. Open Class Photography will be judged Sunday preceding the fair at 9:00 A.M.
3. Exhibitors are required to fill out the entry blank with the proper Department, Section and Class Number with the name of the article and description.
4. Entry blanks in the back of fair book may be used. Additional entry blanks are available at the fair office or at [www.cattarauguscofair.com](http://www.cattarauguscofair.com).
5. **Entries close Monday, July 18th at 4:00 P.M. This is an absolute deadline!**
6. Entry fee has been waived by the Fair Association. However, an entry form **must** be submitted so entry tags/stubs can be issued and prizes awarded.
7. **All articles must be delivered on Saturday preceding the fair between 10:00 A.M. & 2:00 P.M.**
8. Entries may be made by mail. If entry is received and postage is enclosed, tags will be mailed. Otherwise, tags will be held at the office. Please return all unused entry tags/stubs (items not entered) to the Superintendent the day of entry. This will help move the judging along faster.
9. All exhibits must remain on display the last day of the fair. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entry stubs must be presented for removal of articles.
10. All articles must be picked up on **Monday, following the fair** from 10:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M. The Association will not be responsible for articles left after 2:00 P.M. on that day.
11. **All articles must be entered in the real maker's name.**
12. The same article cannot compete for separate premiums.
13. Only recent works will be accepted. Art works entered in fair from previous years will not be accepted.
14. Premiums may be withheld at the discretion of the Judge on unworthy entries. Where there is no competition in the Class of a Section, it is at the discretion of the Judge what premium will be given to that **"one"** image/object.
15. All items must be checked in with the Superintendent for proper class and hanging procedures.
16. **All entries must be matted. \*\*\*NO FRAMES!\*\*\* Matting for snapshots (4x6 picture) may not exceed 5" x 7". Matting for enlargements (8x10 picture) may not exceed 11" x 14".**
17. **Any entry not meeting specified framing procedures will not be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!**
18. Entry size is limited, not to exceed 2 ft. x 2 ft.
19. Special award money will be issued on Monday following the fair.

Note: Collage is an **overlapping** of images (photos, drawings, object, etc.) in a single frame. A single frame containing more than one opening within the frame (i.e. where the photos don't touch) does not qualify as a collage. There is NO LIMIT to the number of images in a collage.
