8 TEAMS: 3 / 4 CARS PER TEAM



THE OBJECT:

PUSH the 6-foot football down the track to the goal line, **Not to Demolish Cars!** Pushing opponent's cars is legal play, crashing into opponent's cars is a penalty. The football is placed in the center of the track. The team getting the ball over the goal line scores a **TOUCHDOWN**. Each game has a time limit. Each team consists of 3 or 4 cars. 2 cars from 2 teams will be on the playing field during competition. Anytime a car leaves, a substitute car may enter.

8 - TEAM PROGRAM:

These 8 teams will compete among one another. **EXAMPLE:** Team #1 will play Team #2; Team #3 will play Team #4, etc. Each event will last approximately 15 minutes. Once all games have been played, the two "Winning Teams" scoring the most touchdowns (points) will advance to the **CHAMPIONSHIP SUPER BOWL EVENT.**

CHAMPIONSHIP SUPER BOWL PURSE

DISTRIBUTION:

Of the two teams that advance to the Championship, the "Winning Team" receives \$1,000 and each member will receive a trophy. The "Second Place" team will receive \$500 and each member will receive a trophy.

ENTRY INFORMATION:

1. Entry fee (\$15/\$60 per team) should be made payable to JM Productions, Inc.; and must be a Money Order, Bank Draft or Business Check. **NO PERSONAL CHECKS ACCEPTED.**
2. Mail entry (on back of sheet), and fee to: **JM PRODUCTIONS, INC., 4751 Southwestern Blvd. Hamburg, NY 14075**
3. You may enter as an individual or as a team. **EACH** team will consist of 3 or 4 cars.
4. **NON-winning** teams may participate as back-up cars for other teams.
5. Include your first and second choice for team colors. Colors will be approved on a first come first serve basis. JM Productions will notify the team captain of approved colors in an acceptance letter.
6. If your team has a sponsor, please include the sponsor's name on the entry form (only one sponsor is permitted).
7. All drivers must pre-enter to guarantee acceptance. Avoid late Entry Fee (\$25) at Pit Gate and enter early!
8. **PIT PASSES (\$10):** This pit pass fee includes Participant Secondary Medical Insurance and Fair gate admission. All additional pit crew, mechanics, etc., must also purchase a pit pass for \$10, which includes Secondary Medical Insurance and Fair gate admission.
9. You must be 16 years old to enter the pits. Anyone under the age of 18 must sign a Minor's Release with a parent or guardian during the pit gate hours.
10. **PIT GATE:** Hours are 5:00 pm - 6:00 pm. Please use the 10th Street Gate Entrance along Route 353 to enter Pit Gate. Drivers who arrive late will not compete.

RULES WILL APPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING EXCEPTIONS. Minimum weight limit is 2800lbs. Any cylinder size car may be used within the weight limits. If you have ANY questions, please give us a call, Monday through Friday between 10:00 am and 4:00 pm. (716)648-5100

1. Drivers may install an "APPROVED INSIDE GAS TANK," a marine-type gas tank is highly recommended. Firewall is mandatory.
2. Gas tank must be securely fastened and covered in the area vacated by the rear seat or in the trunk area over the rear axle. **NO RUBBER HOLD DOWNS PERMITTED!**
3. Gas line must run underneath car and all fittings must be secure and leak proof. All electric fuel pumps must be located under the car body and must shut off with the ignition switch.
4. All stock gas tanks must be removed if you are installing an inside tank.
5. Chrysler Imperials and leaf spring wagons will NOT be permitted!
6. Bumpers maybe hard nosed, welded and reinforced but must remain smooth to prevent cuts in the hall. All rubber, plastic and brackets must be removed. WD-40 is permitted.
7. 2 or 4 door vehicles with no center post must have a roll bar.
8. Only the driver side doors can be welded.
9. Car differentials, transmissions and exhaust systems may be modified.

2010 RULES AND REGULATIONS

RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. READ THEM CAREFULLY. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO UNDERSTAND ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS. CALL 716-648-5100 WITH QUESTIONS. SEE JM PRODUCTIONS ENTRY FOR ADDITIONAL RULE CHANGES.

DRIVERS:

1. All drivers are required to complete and sign an entry blank. Derby officials may accept or reject any entry. Entries not accepted will be notified.
2. Drivers and crew members are independent contractors, not employees of the Ag. Society or promoter. Only those who have signed release sheets will be allowed in pit area or on the track.
3. Drivers must be 16 years of age and must have a valid driver's license. ID will be required upon signing in at the pit gate.
4. Drivers must wear clean, long-sleeved coveralls or jackets.
5. Drivers must wear approved safety helmets. Drivers must wear some form of eye protection: a shield on the helmet, athletic glasses or safety glasses.
6. Drivers must wear seat belts/shoulder harnesses. Any car without a working shoulder harness will be disqualified.
7. All drivers and owners must attend the drivers meeting 30 minutes prior to the contest.
8. All drivers must apply their own car.
9. Driver and/or pit crew will be automatically disqualified for harassment of any official.

PERFORMANCE:

1. Alcohol/Drugs – If any driver, owner or crew member is seen consuming or has consumed any alcoholic beverage or drugs at any time prior to or during the derby, his/her car will be completely disqualified and the persons involved will be removed from the grounds. Alcoholic beverages and coolers are prohibited in the infield and its area.
2. Drivers may maneuver forward or backward. No deliberate head-on collisions or hitting in the driver's door. This rule will be strictly enforced.
3. You must stay in your car. Do not loosen safety belt or helmet. Do not leave your car unless you are told to do so by an official.
4. Any member of the officiating crew or any authorized police agency of the Fair has the right to reject, remove or disqualify, at any time, any person or persons who violate any of these rules and regulations. In doing so, such person forfeits all fees, pit passes and prize money.
5. Drivers exhibiting misconduct will face a two-year suspension. Future violations will result in permanent suspension from contests sponsored by the Cattaraugus County Agricultural Society.

INSPECTION – Derby officials reserve the right to inspect any and all cars entered at any time.

SAFETY AND CAR INSPECTIONS – Any exception of the rules will be called illegal and the car will be disqualified. All changes and work on car MUST be completed BEFORE the car enters the grounds. NO CAR WILL BE ADMITTED TO THE GROUNDS UNLESS THE FOLLOWING ITEMS HAVE BEEN ADHERED TO:

1. Any 2 or 4 door hardtop car is allowed, except cars whose manufactured weight is less than 2800 pounds. No 4-wheel drive equipped or commercial vehicles, jeeps, trucks, hearses, T-tops or Imperials are allowed.
2. The cutting of fenders or bumpers is not permitted.
3. No special bumpers, trailer hitches, or reinforcements will be allowed. No chaining of any suspension, welding to any spring or spring support. Bumpers must be chained on frame.
4. All glass, including windshield, headlights, mirrors, etc. must be removed. Sun visors should also be removed. Car must be swept clean of all loose dirt. Cars with broken glass in door and inside body panels are not permitted. All work must be completed before arrival.
5. All chrome and decorative ornaments, as well as plastic parts, must be removed from outside and inside the car. Protruding fenders or tail light fins must be bent over.

6. FUEL TANKS –

Small cars: If gas tank is ahead of axle, tank can be used. If it is not, you must have secure fuel cell and all gas line wires must run underneath the car. Otherwise car will not be allowed to run.

Large cars: Must have secure fuel cell and all gas line wires must run underneath the car. Otherwise car will not be allowed to run.

Inside gas tanks must be used in rear seat area. Securely fasten and completely cover with metal shield. Boat tank is advised. Absolutely NO plastic tanks. Any gas spillage is automatic disqualification. No more than 3 gallons of gasoline permitted.

7. Rusted out floor areas inside vehicle must be repaired by securely covering with metal.
8. All trunk lids must be chained or banded shut. Doors may be welded or chained. Driver door protection is optional. If used, car must have exterior steel plate of approximately 5/16" thickness and 12" wide. Steel plate can be no more than 12" before and 12" after driver door. This steel plate may not strengthen the main structure of the rest of the car and must be fastened securely. Steel plate must be bolted with bolts facing in, not out, so they do not extrude from the car.
9. Hood and trunk springs must be removed. Chaining of hood is mandatory with no heavier than 3/8" chain. No more than two chains and no bolting hoods down. Chains or rods from car roof to dash panel are required.
10. Battery (12 volts only), solenoid, voltage regulators may be relocated inside if they are well-secured and covered.
11. All hoods must have a 12" x 12" hole cut in over the battery.
12. Stock air cleaners must be in place. Stock carburetor and air filter must be in place.
13. Driver/sponsor lettering is permitted, if in good taste.
14. Radiator must remain in original position.
15. Doors on both sides must be painted white and must be dry before entering the grounds. A 2' x 2' section of white must be painted on the roof of car for car number. Numbers will be painted on cars as they pass inspection. If you run the first night, you must repaint the white on doors and roof for second night.
16. Cars must have working brakes before entering the fairgrounds.
17. Some safety rules may be imposed at time of derby due to track conditions.
18. Tires – Passenger car tires or LT tires only. No truck tires or mudders allowed. Stock or option size with or without tube. No inter-liner or double tires permitted. 13", 14" or 15" tires only.
19. Drivers protesting another car must pay \$50.00 and must do so before the drivers meeting or after the feature event.
20. If any emergency arises during an event all cars will be stopped. If any cars must be removed to allow emergency equipment to operate, they must remain in their original position to resume heat. If it is not necessary to remove any cars during an emergency, the heat will resume from the present position.
21. Officials may inspect cars before, during and after each event. The Feature winner's car will be inspected in a secured area until the officials are satisfied.
22. Air bags – Deactivate and / or remove air bags.
23. Secure fuel cell.
24. Large cars only: 22" maximum bumper height front and rear.
25. All cars must be stock unless modification is stated in the rules.
26. Suspension must be stock. No twistees, hi-jackers, etc. Stock heights, leaf sprints must be stock. Car must move up and down. Leaf springs must stagger down in stock spring length from shortest to longest.
27. No coil spring cars can be converted to leaf springs.
28. Tie rods, A-arms and ball joints must remain stock.
29. No extra pipes, welding, fill modification or reinforcing of suspension or frame. (STOCK is the keyword!)
30. Bumpers must be secured. You may swap bumpers (no truck bumpers or homemade bumpers.) Bumpers may only be interchanged with another car bumper. You can "tack" weld bumper brackets or towers to frame.
31. No welding on the bumpers, shock or brackets. DO NOT ADD ANY METAL!
32. You may weld or bolt a pipe behind the seat from doorpost to doorpost. It should be mounted at approximately chest height of the seated driver. You may also weld in a pipe across where the dash was. Pipes may be no bigger than 2" in diameter. You may also attach, weld or bolt an exterior plate across the driver door. The plate may extend no more than 6" past seam. It may be no more than 1/2" thick and 12" wide. You may weld the driver's door shut, but not on the inside.
