GENERAL INFORMATION FOR ALL DEPARTMENTS

(Also see information specific to each department)

- Competition is open to all residents of all counties
- Entry blanks can be found here or may be picked up at the fair office.
- **Entries close Wednesday, July 13 at 4:00 PM**
- No entries accepted other than those listed
- Entry fee has been waived
- Entries may be made by mail. If postage is enclosed (1 stamp for every 6 entries), tags will be mailed, otherwise they will be held at the office.
- **All entries must be picked up on Sunday, following the Fair, from 10 AM to 1 PM. Entry stubs must be presented at pick up. The Fair is NOT responsible for any articles left after 1 PM.**
- Entries must be checked in with the Superintendent. Return any unused tags to the Superintendent. This will help when judging.
- Special award money will be issued on Sunday following the Fair, with premium checks.

DEPARTMENT T – ADULT ART SHOW

18 years & over

- **Items must be delivered Thursday, July 28, 4 PM-8 PM or Friday, July 29, Noon-8 PM.**
- Art will be judged preceding the Fair.
- **Limit 3 per Section / 2 per class.**
- The same article cannot compete for separate premiums.
- Only recent works will be accepted. Art works entered in Fair from previous years will not be accepted.
- All entries must be properly framed or finished and ready to hang. Framing consists of plastic, wood or metal. Hanging wire should be attached to frame with eye hooks. Painting/Drawing must be able to hang from a hook.
- Any entry not meeting specified framing and hanging procedures will not be accepted. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- **NO DUCT TAPE**
- If using Gallery Canvas, sides must be painted.
- Entry size limit – **not to exceed 24"x24"**.
- **Please refer to general rules.**

Note: Collage is an overlapping of images in a single frame. A single frame containing more than one opening within the frame (i.e. where the images don't touch) does not qualify as a collage. There is NO LIMIT to the number of images in a collage.
