- Any specimen in a hanging container must be entered under the hanging basket category.
- Any cut flowers, potted plants or arrangement having insects and/or pests will not be accepted.
- Specimen will be displayed in vase which will be provided by the Domestic Superintendent.
- 1 stem or 1 spray (include attached foliage) per item permitted, unless specified.
- Give names of varieties when possible
- Exhibitors should maintain their exhibits in good condition.
